Summer Rentals



If you are renting your home this season we have some suggestions for you and your potential renters. If garbage service isn't included in your lease agreement inform the renters that they must obtain a service or dispose of the trash legally. Persons found dumping illegally in any of the public parks and/or private dumpsters will be charged with *Theft of Services*, a misdemeanor. Placement of the trash containers is also important. All trash has to be placed in closed leak proof containers located under the house or behind the front line of the house. It is unlawful to place trash containers at the edge of the driveway, even for pickup. All the carting companies in the area are aware of this local law and will cooperate with you. Parking is always a problem. Each home is permitted to have one vehicle per bedroom plus one extra. For example if you have a five bedroom house you may park six vehicles on the property. The village noise pollution ordinances are in effect between the hours of 11:00pm and 7:00am. Those people shouting, yelling, playing loud music, etc. during those hours are in violation of this local law. Copies of all these local laws are available online on the village website (www.whdunes.org). If your tenants wish to have a large gathering during their stay encourage them to meet with the police constabulary at least two weeks prior. It's not mandatory but we can assist them with parking additional vehicles and other issues. Our goal is for everyone to have a enjoyable and safe summer season.
